### Foundation Stage: Sporting Ted

#### Workshop Summary



The workshop enables children to explore and enjoy the Museum's Rowing Gallery with the help of Sporting Ted. They will find out about the boats, how boats are rowed, what rowers wear, how they train and what they eat.

#### Workshop Contents

##### Education Centre (Museum Tutor led)

- An introduction to and short story about Sporting Ted and his rowing adventures
- Make a collage about Sporting Ted
- Design a healthy breakfast for sporting Ted

##### Henley Gallery (Museum Tutor led)

- Children will find out what Henley Regatta was like a long time ago – with the help of Sporting Ted's great, great grandfather Ernest
- They will handle special objects and guess what they are

##### Rowing Gallery (Teacher led)

- Children will carry out matching and sorting activities to help them find all that Sporting Ted needs to be a champion rower

#### Learning Outcomes

- Learn to cope in an unfamiliar environment
- Develop new vocabulary, speaking and listening skills
- Develop creative skills
- Find out about healthy eating
