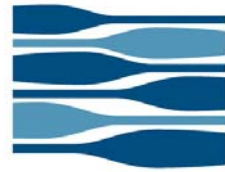


## River & Rowing Museum

### Pre-Foundation and Foundation Stage: Playworks

#### Workshop Summary



The workshop gives the children a chance to explore and discover the wider world in a safe and unique environment. It links to many early learning goals and introduces the children to the Museum setting using the Museum's collections of objects.

#### Workshop Contents

##### Education Centre (Museum Tutor led)

- A creative carousel of activities
- Choose from a selection of topics including boats, ducks or the seasons
- Children handle real objects

##### Galleries (Museum Tutor led)

- Children join Francesca Frog on a boat hunt throughout the galleries
- A visit to the Wind in the Willows exhibition is included with the workshop

#### Learning Outcomes

- Learn to cope in an unfamiliar environment
- Develop new vocabulary, speaking and listening skills
- Develop social skills sharing and taking turns
- An awareness and introduction to the museum environment
- Development of imagination and creative skills

- The workshop links to many of the early learning goals for each of the six areas of Learning and Development
