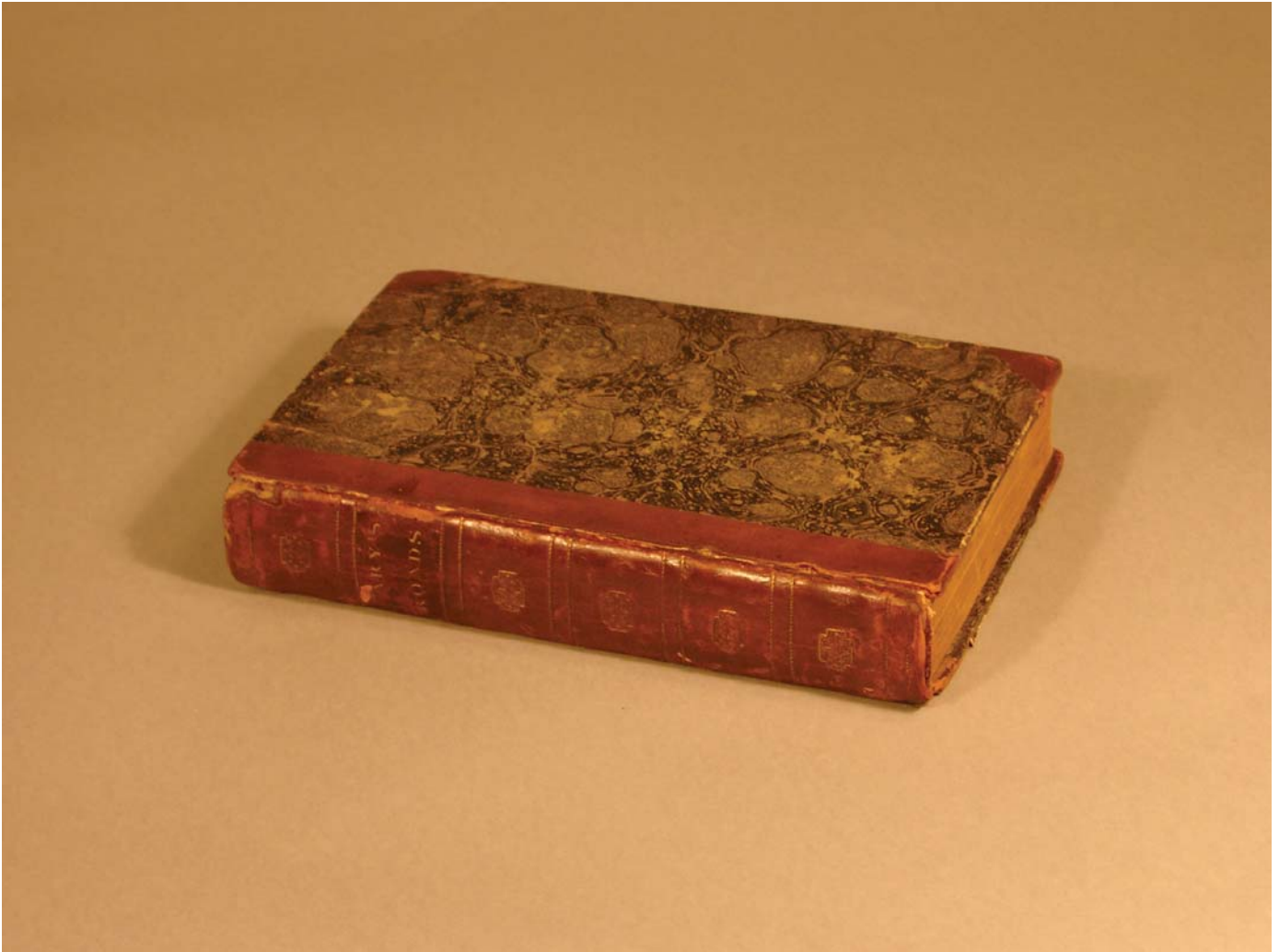


Henley History: a Sense of Place
