Post Horn



This is a copper post or coaching horn, which is made up of three different parts.

A Coaching horn was sounded by the coachman to inform the toll gate keepers on turnpike roads of his approach. On the approach to Henley the coachmen bringing the mail would sound their horns at the top of Remenham Hill so that the toll gate was open on their arrival and they would not have to stop.
