The Whistle



This whistle is an 'Acme Thunderer'. Although it is not marked with a Great Western Railways logo it is typical of the type of whistle used on the railway throughout the nineteenth century.

The guard would have blown the whistle as a warning prior to the departure of the train, and again as he waved the green flag just as the train left the platform.
