

# Living Thing Thaumatrope

## Did you know...?

- A living thing that needs to eat another living thing to survive is called a **consumer**.
- Some living things, like plants, produce their own food.

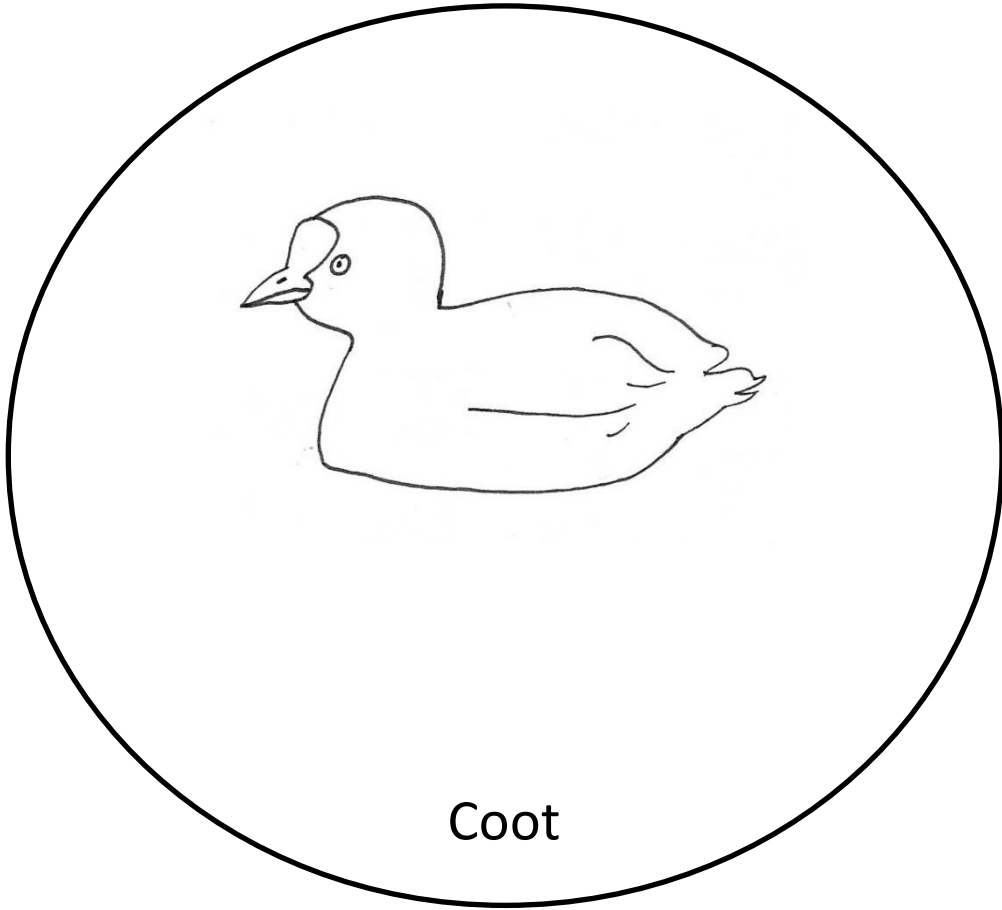
## You will need:

- Scissors
- Glue
- Colouring pencils
- A paper straw or rolled up paper to make a thin tube or a pencil

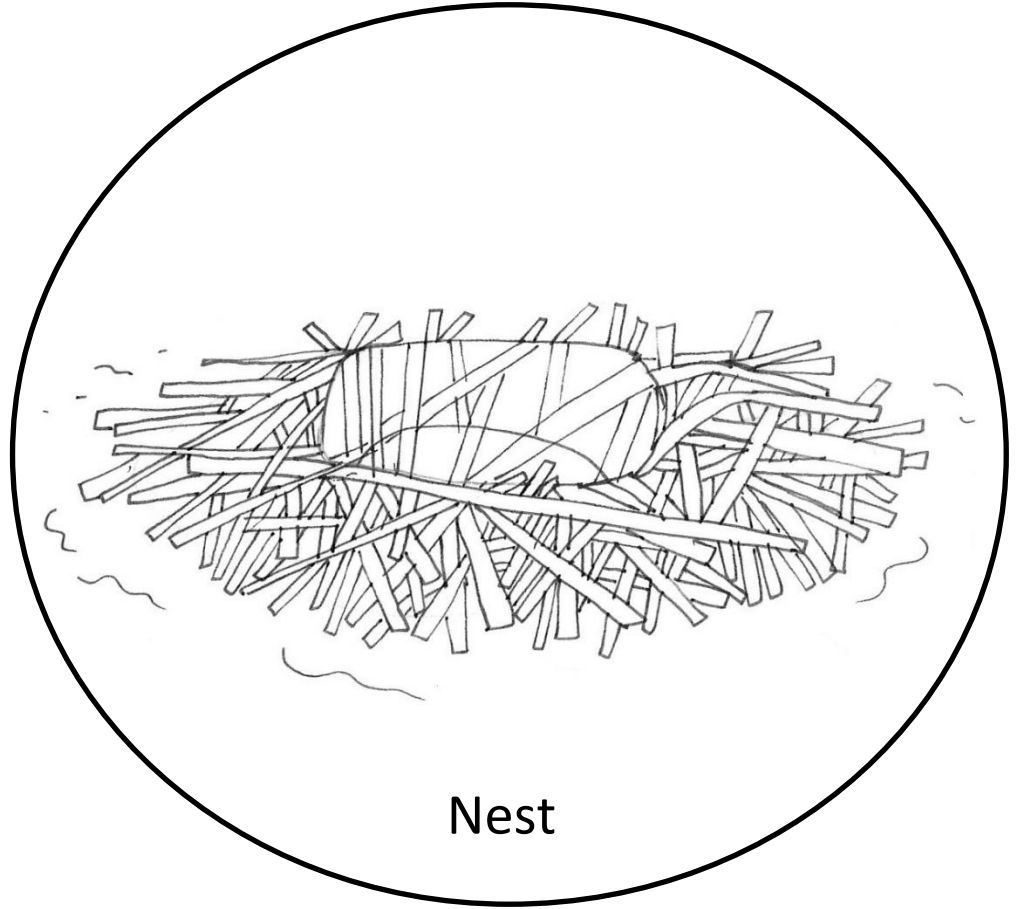
## To make your thaumatrope:

- Colour in both the images for the thaumatrope. There are 3 designs to choose from on following pages.
- Cut out the circles.
- Glue the back of one of the circles.
- Place a paper straw in the middle of this circle. This will be the handle. If you don't have a paper straw you can use a piece of paper rolled up to make a thin tube, or a pencil.
- Making sure both the pictures are the right way up, stick the second circle back to back with the first.
- To see one living thing inside the other, put the thaumatrope handle between your hands and rub them together.
- Don't forget to look at the fact files to find out more about these living things!

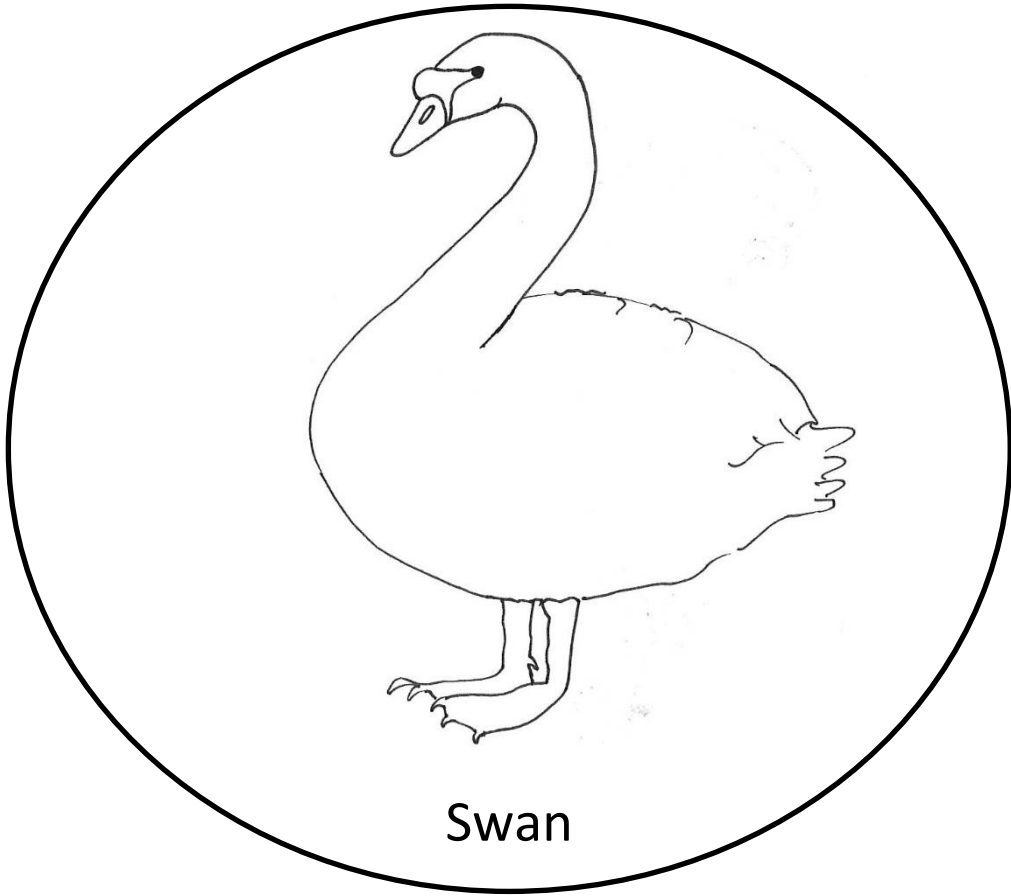




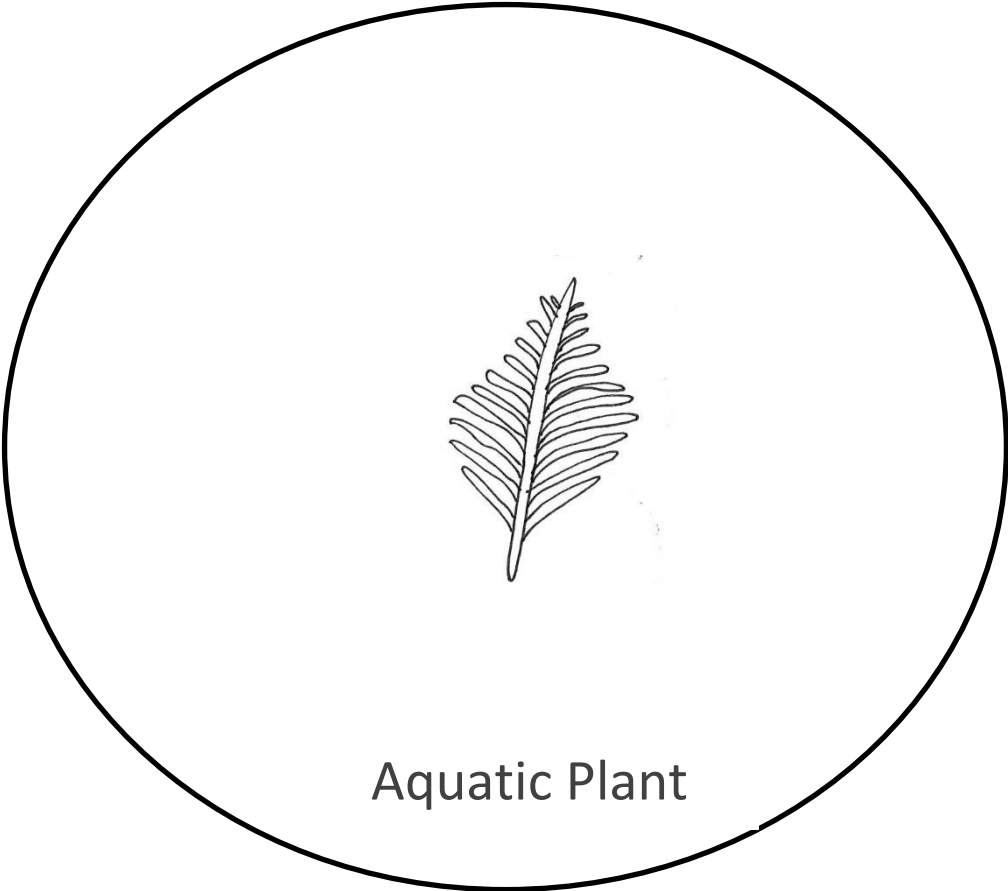

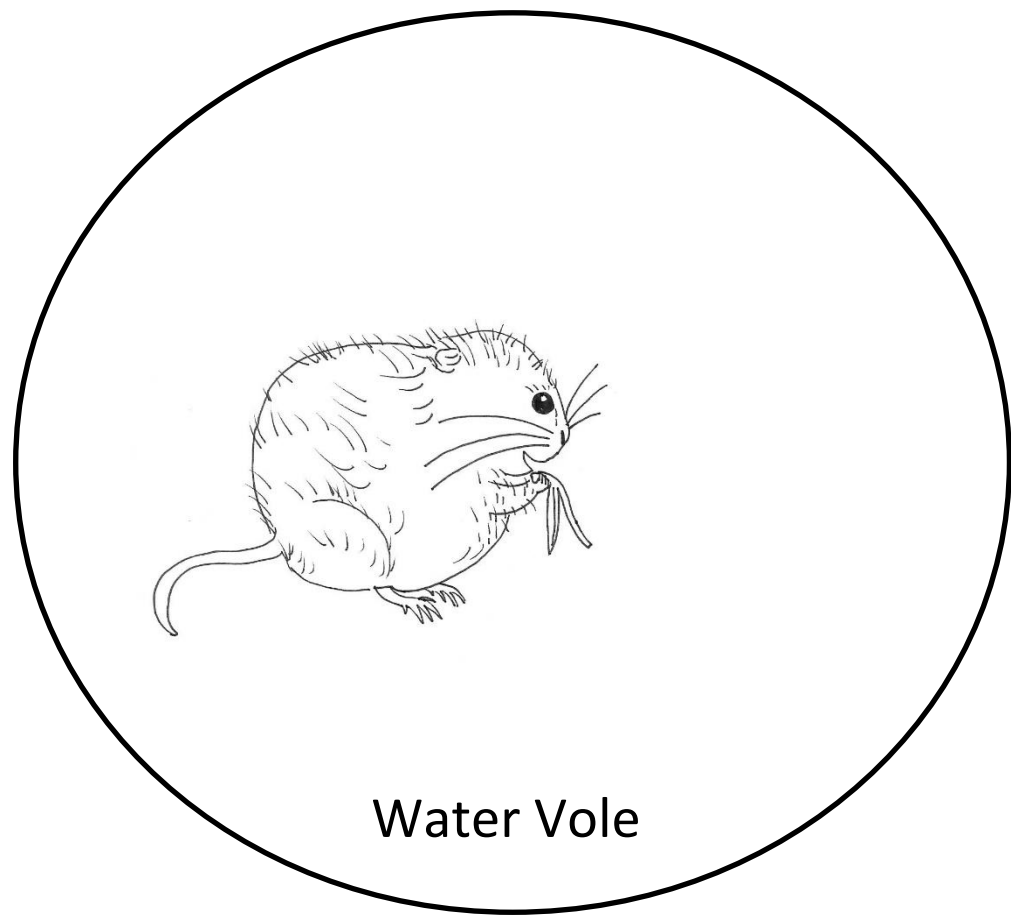
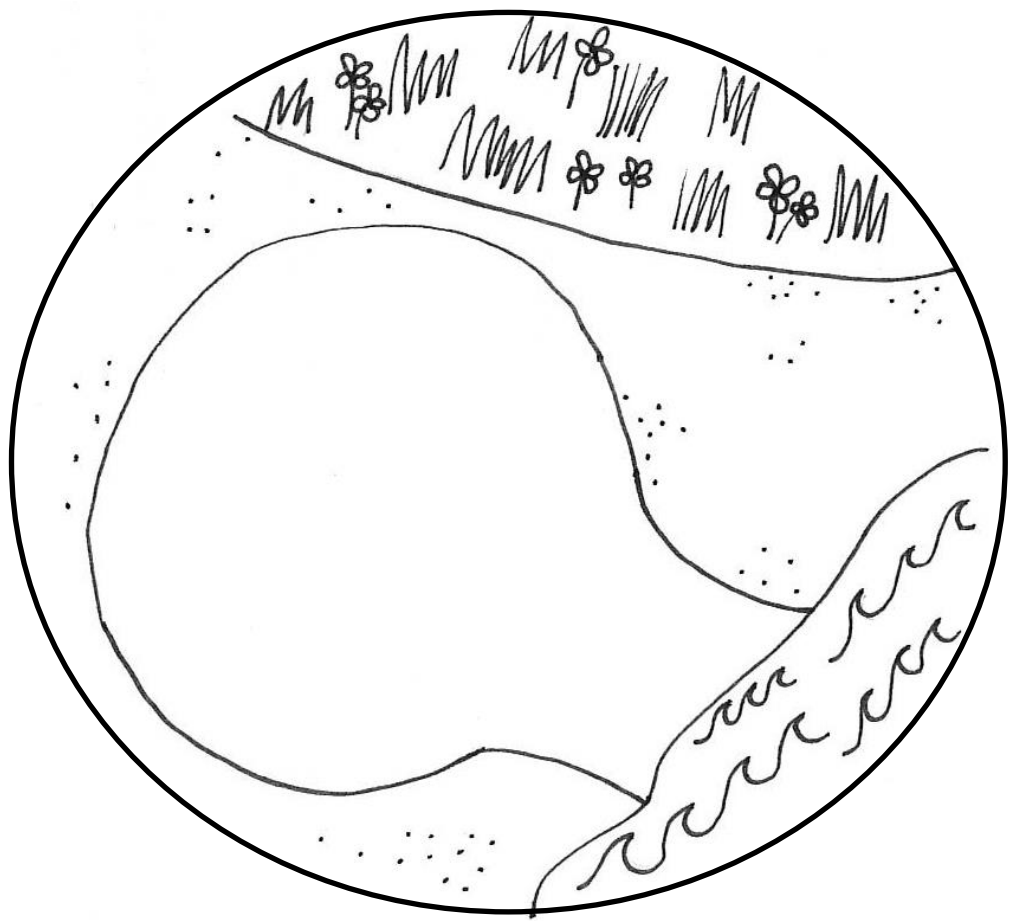
Nest
