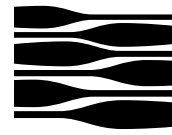


Artist Adventure: Imagination Creations

These activities aim to stretch your imagination. There is no right or wrong answer so enjoy yourself, be curious and get creative!

Choose an object. What is this object used for? When and where would it have been used?

You can read the museum labels to find out or you could imagine what the answer might be.

Imagine who the owner of the object was and draw them. They can be as realistic or as fantastical as you like!

Top Tip: Think about what this person does a job? What do they enjoy? Do they wear a uniform or would it be clothes from a specific place or time?

Find a boat in the Museum. How would you describe your boat? Is it old, new, fast or slow?

Imagine you are going on a journey in the boat, where would you go? Is your destination a new place or somewhere you know? Are you travelling somewhere real or imaginary? **Draw your destination.**

3 **Find a picture.** This could be a photograph or painting. What is happening in the picture?
This picture is moment in time. **Try drawing what happens next.**

4 **Choose an object.** What is this object used for? Where would you normally find this object?
Imagine you can travel back in time and see the object in its original setting.
Have a go a drawing where this object would normally live.
