What you will be doing:

- Give a friendly and customer focused welcome to all visitors and to ensure they leave having had an enjoyable and memorable experience.
- Assist visitors in navigating the Museums one-way system.
- Create a welcoming and accessible atmosphere by signposting visitors to museum resources that will enhance their visit.
- Assist our Front of House team to ensure the smooth running of the public areas of the Museum.
- Support the Front of House team by carrying out light cleaning duties.
- Assist the Front of House team in carrying out the evacuation procedure.
- Develop a basic knowledge of the Museum and our collection, so that any questions from visitors can be dealt with in a professional manner.

Required hours:

- There will be 2 shifts per day from 9.50 - 13.30 and 13.30 - 16.15. You can choose to do regular or ad hoc shifts however; we are ideally looking for volunteers who can commit to a minimum of 2 shifts per month.
- Please note that The River & Rowing Museum is currently open Thursday to Monday from 10.00 – 16.00. You can use our car park free of charge on the days you are volunteering
